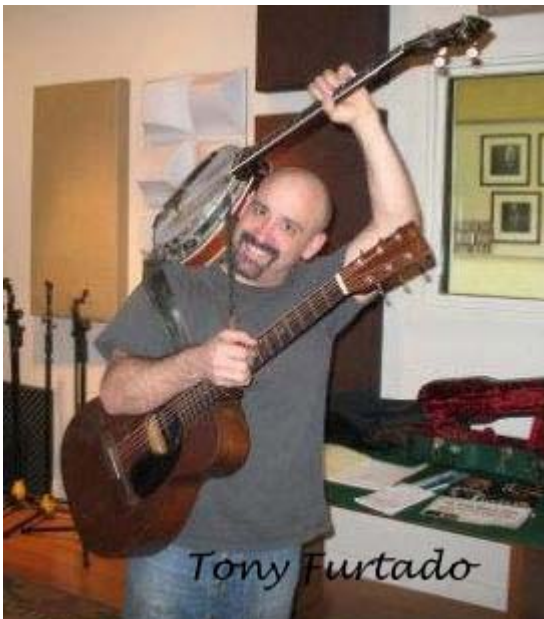
## Mollie O'Brien Concert Co-sponsored by KVNF !
