## KC Groves & Riley Baugus Concert



KC Groves and Riley Baugus are appearing in the Community Room at KVNF, Thursday, June 18, starting at 7:30 pm. This concert, co-sponsored by Pickin' Productions, has limited seating available so you'll want to get to the show early at KVNF. Tickets will be sold at the door and all tickets are only \$15.00.

Riley Baugus perhaps best known for his singing on the soundtrack to the Academy Award winning film "Cold Mountain" is a North Carolina native who began singing and playing music at an early age. Raised in a household where recordings of old-time

music were often played, he developed a love and appreciation for traditional, Southern Appalachian music. He and his family attended the Regular Baptist church, where unaccompanied singing was the tradition. Riley then began honing his musical skills with close friend and neighbor, fiddler Kirk Sutphin. He often visited, played with, and learned from fiddlers Tommy Jarrell (a National Heritage Award recipient) and Robert Sykes, banjo player Dix Freeman, former Camp Creek Boys Verlin Clifton and Paul Sutphin.

KC's love for traditional music also started in a southern church where instruments were prohibited. She is the founding member of the band Uncle Earl and currently plays an important role in the thriving acoustic music scene in Colorado. She is a well-respected vocalist, instrumentalist, and songwriter. She was the recipient of a Detroit Bluegrass award for the first of her two solo albums, as well as a finalist in the Telluride Troubadour competition in 2000. KC's intensive study of traditional bluegrass music comes through in her keen harmony sense and tasteful mandolin playing. She has performed in concert with Darol Anger and Ben Kauffman, of Yonder Mountain Stringband, Billy Nershi of The Stringcheese Incident and recorded with Leftover Salmon. She is currently busy with projects, The Moody Sisters and The Blue Maddies. Groves calls Lyons, CO home.

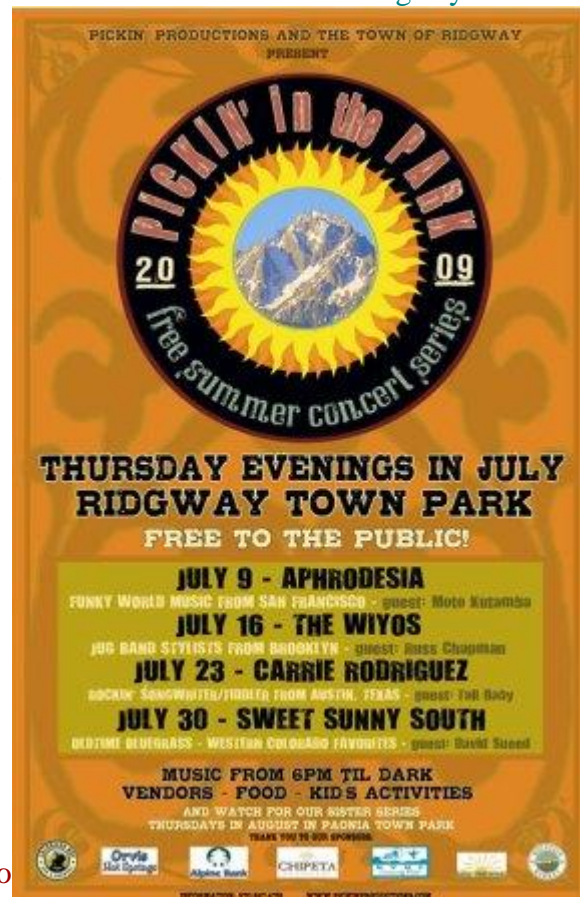


## Get Ready for Pickin' in the Park
