If you missed the KVNF Annual Meeting October 28 here are the headlines.

KVNF continues to operate in the black and rebuild our 3 month reserve. The Board of Directors (BoD) developed a 3 year strategic plan that will be reviewed on an annual basis. Analyzing and protecting our signal network (KVNF 90.9 and KVMT 89.1 and all of our translators) will be a priority for FY 2008.

Adam Silverstein resigned from the BOD in August and Phil Egidi has been appointed to serve the remainder of Adam's term. Great thanks to Adam for his many years of service. Welcome to Phil, who is no stranger to KVNF and brings vast technical knowledge that will be exceedingly helpful in developing a signal protection plan.
