



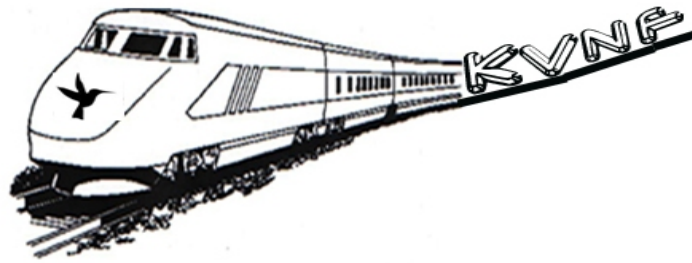

Before the Music Dies

In conjunction with the Fall Pledge Drive, KVNF is showing the documentary "Before the Music Dies", Monday, September 17 at 7:30 pm at the Paradise Theatre in Paonia. Come on out to rally for independent media.
